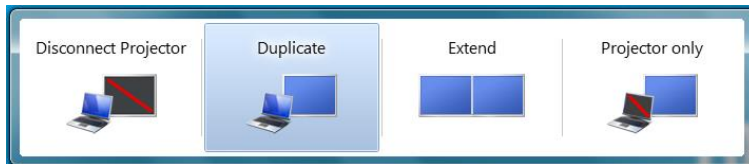


Extended View or Duplicate View

One of the teaching advantages of computers is to use multiple displays. Most of us use a laptop with a secondary display. This allows us to have two separate displays at once. There are times that you would like for your students to see one thing, while you look at another. In this case, you would use a feature called Extended View.

To activate or deactivate extended view: (Lenovo Laptops)

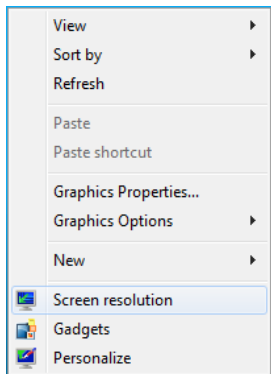
1. Press the "Fn" (function) key and the "F7" key at the same time.
2. This will bring up the following choice screen.



3. At this point you can choose which view you would like to use. Click on the choice and the computer will make the changes.

Not all laptops have the same Key combinations, so there is another way to perform this operation.

1. Right Click on the Desktop
2. In the Menu that appears click Screen Resolution



3. In the screen that appears, click the dropdown arrow next to Multiple displays: and make the correct choice.
