



2020-2021 School Based Flu Program Information for Parents/Guardians

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This influenza (flu) season the Treutlen County Health Department would like to help protect our school-age kids by providing flu vaccine during school hours. This year the school-based program will be a little different. To eliminate the amount of papers going home and back to the school, all information and consents will be electronic. If your child has health insurance, we will bill your insurance provider, otherwise there is no out of pocket cost. We will only have the injectable (shot) flu vaccine available this year.

Influenza Vaccination Clinic Date and Location:

NOVEMBER 17, 2020 **TREUTLEN COUNTY SCHOOLS**

The last date that forms will be accepted is **NOVEMBER 15, 2020**. The electronic submission will no longer be active after this date. Late forms will NOT be accepted.

If you would like your child vaccinated during the above school-based flu clinic, please:

1. Review the Vaccine Information Statement (VIS) by visiting qrco.de/bbiGEd or scanning the QR code below with your phone.



2. Review the Notice of Privacy by visiting qrco.de/bbl9Yb or scanning the QR code below with your phone.



3. Fill out the electronic consent form by visiting https://forms.office.com/Pages/ResponsePage.aspx?id=DaEtURsHIEuKvJ7EBE0VFroGNoxjoWZOi_Rc_kFoD-dUNDdRS01GTDVKM0FJWVZNVEVLNUxMVVRBWC4u or scanning the QR code below with your phone. The form must be filled out in its entirety. If forms are not completed or have missing information, your child will NOT be vaccinated at the school. A form must be completed for each student. If you DO NOT want your child to receive the flu vaccine, you DO NOT have to fill out this form.



Children up to 8 years of age may need a second dose approximately one month after the first dose. We will provide the second dose during visit 2.

We thank you in advance for helping to keep our students safe and healthy. If you have any questions about the influenza vaccine, please feel free to contact the school nurse, health care provider, or the local health department.

Please note that participation and receipt of influenza vaccine through this program is completely voluntary. The health care provider for your child can answer questions about the influenza virus and will be able to vaccinate your child against seasonal influenza.
